#### Graded Areas – That will be reflected in the progress report: -

- **Co-Scholastic Activities:** For the holistic development of the student, co-curricular activities in the following areas be carried out in CBSE affiliated schools by the teachers and will be graded term-wise on a 3-point grading scale (**A=Outstanding, B=Very Good and C=Fair**). The aspect of regularity, sincere participation, output and teamwork be the generic criteria for grading in the following Co-scholastic activities.
  - **Work Education** - Work Education refers to skill-based activities resulting in goods or services useful to the community – ICT / Whole school Charity.
  - **Art Education** – Art / Dance/ Music
  - **Health and Physical Education** (Sports/PE/House Event Participation).
- **Discipline:** The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behaviour, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others. Grading on Discipline will be done term-wise on a 3-point grading scale (**A=Outstanding, B=Very Good and C=Fair**)
